Ryde will benefit from a £20m regeneration fund. The funding is intended to be spent on local people's priorities including regenerating town centres and improving transport.



Ryde is to benefit from regeneration of the Interchange and Esplanade, improving the tourist and leisure offer for both residents and visitors


